Biographical Summary

I am a licensed mental health counselor and AASECT certified sex therapist in private practice in Portland, Oregon, serving Florida, Oregon, and New Mexico clients. I specialize in treating LGBTQ+, Kinky, and Consensually Nonmonogamous (CNM) clients.

I completed my Bachelor of Arts in Religious Studies in 2006 and my Master of Arts in Clinical Psychology in 2009. In 2018, I began doctoral studies in Clinical Psychology. My doctoral studies focused on gender, sexual, and relationship diversity (GSRD). I am currently working on a dissertation studying the trends in the stigmatization of kink-involved populations in academic literature and mass news media. I hope that this study will contribute to recognizing kink as a sexually diverse minority and nudge society toward a greater kink acceptance.

In 2020, I became a lead research assistant on the international Kink Health Survey research team lead by Dr. Sprott and Dr. Randall. In 2022, I was appointed as a Research Scientist at The Alternative Sexuality and Research Alliance (TASHRA). I am currently involved in several research projects with TASHRA including the International Kink Health Study, PrEP for Kink, The Authority Transfer Study, and a study currently in design on kink and healing. My research interests include gender, sexual, and relationship diversity (GSRD).

Finally, I serve in professional volunteer positions such as the American Association of Sexuality Educators, Counselors, and Therapists (AASECT), The National Coalition for Sexual Freedom (NCSF), The Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality (SSSS), and The Alternative Sexualities Health Research Alliance (TASHRA).
